



Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

In light of Governor Abbott's Executive Order GA-19 it is evident that COVID-19 does not appear to be ending soon. It may well enter some our families and the lives of those we love. Be careful. Be cautious. Be wise and practical in what you do.

The Executive Order is only for counties reporting more than 20 cases of COVID-19. Montague County, at the time of this writing, is only reporting 6 active cases. Furthermore, the Executive Order also provides an exception for houses of worship. The ninth exception listed states that the face covering requirement does not apply to "any person who is actively providing or obtaining access to religious worship but wearing a face covering is strongly encouraged." Therefore, at this time, we will remain in Phase 2 of our strategy for regathering.

Phase Two Strategy:

1. Sunday School will begin 9:45 followed by worship in the sanctuary at 11:00am. There will be no Nursery or Children's Church provided at this time.
2. Hand sanitizer will be available at the door and in the classrooms. We will discourage any touching, hugging, handshaking, etc.
3. The offering plates will not be passed. The offering box will be available at the back of the sanctuary. Additionally, you can drop off, mail, or give online @ <https://www.forestburgbaptist.org/give.html>.
4. We will sanitize frequently contacted surfaces as often as possible (door handles, flat surfaces, etc.). Furthermore, please remember to wash your hands frequently.
5. We encourage anyone who is sick or have any other underlying health concerns to stay home and continue to watch online @ <https://www.forestburgbaptist.org/sermons.html> or Facebook Live (@ForestburgBC).

This strategy is temporary and will progress as circumstances change. We will not be able to immediately go “back to normal.” Please continue to be in prayer as we navigate through this difficult time.
